Staff Meeting – Juniors and Seniors attend a weekly meeting with the Griffin First staff. Each meeting begins with a devotion led by Pastor Valimont. The remaining time is dedicated to planning the week ahead, discussing upcoming events, and presenting new ideas for ministry.

Ministry Practicums – According to their area of interest, a student will assist a pastor in making preparations for his or her ministry. The staff also takes time to teach them the fundamentals and how to build a ministry from the ground up.

Chapel – Chapel allows the students to experience diversity from the pulpit from regional Assembly of God pastors. Following the message, the pastor has an opportunity to spend time with the students and answer questions.

Mission Trips – Students have the opportunity to go on a mission trip during the spring semester each year. Typically, they may choose from two options.
